The park is set in the heart of the Canadian Rockies and attracts approx. 4 million visitors each year. It's also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

### **Tuesday 09th August 2016**

Today's sightseeing will include some of the most famous features in the Canadian Rockies. With the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise proudly standing at one end and the Victoria Glacier reflecting off the other, Lake Louise is one of the sights most often preserved in photographs by visitors from all over the world.

- En-route to Lake Louise, visit Moraine Lake in the Valley of the Ten Peaks
- After checking in at the hotel, the rest of the day is free

### **Wednesday 10th August 2016**

Highway 93, known as the Icefield Parkway, qualifies as one of the most scenic drives in the world. It traverses more than 100 glaciers, pristine lakes and some of the highest Rockies.

- Columbia Icefield and the Athabasca Glacier - enjoy a guided tour out onto the Glacier
- Buffet lunch at Columbia Icefield Chalet is included
- The overnight destination is Jasper in Jasper National Park
- Overnight Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge (B,L,D)

### **Thursday 11th August 2016**

Board Rocky Mountain Rail Tours' "Rocky Mountaineer." Your adventure begins as you board the train and depart Jasper, traveling along the Miette River to Yellowhead Pass. Just past Yellowhead Lake, you'll meet up with the headwaters of the Fraser River. The Rocky Mountaineer will cross the North Thompson River several times before arriving in Kamloops.

- Continental breakfast, lunch and snacks are included onboard
- Overnight at a Kamloops hotel (B,L,D)



### **Friday 12th August 2016**

Soon after your departure from Kamloops, follow the Thompson River and watch the landscape give way to the high, steep walls and "40 miles of hell" of the Fraser Canyon. The route passes over 28 bridges and through 23 tunnels and snow sheds between Kamloops and the small town of Boston Bar. Travel through the fertile Fraser Delta en-route to Vancouver.
